Pleasant Park Neighborhood Association
Monthly business meeting

The meeting was called to order by the President Darryl Dearborn at 7:00 P.M.

No treasurer's report. However, the PPNA money held in the Pleasant Park Arena Association bank account was retrieved and placed in the PPNA bank account. This was approximately \$1700.

It was also moved and seconded to authorize Susan Morris to order 4 signs at \$15 each to be placed along Pleasant Park Road to announce to neighbors the dates of our monthly meetings. Susan has found a sign maker in Bailey. The motion unanimously passed.

No report from the Water committee, but Dick told us that although the rain of the last few days has helped, the ponds are still lower than ever before. Dick also told us that if anyone is interested in a radon testing kit for their home, they can be obtained from the Air Pollution Control Commission or the Jefferson County Health Department.

No report from Planning and Zoning. However, there is a rumor that Conifer Corners is having trouble satisfying the P&Z Board's requirement to show they have a sustainable water supply. It is known that Conifer Corners tried to drill two more wells.

Officer Chris West told us that they are cracking down on bicycles and cars not obeying the laws. Also the fire ban is off in Jefferson County, but fire restrictions remain.

After a discussion of topics for future meetings, we decided to have Peter check on possible speakers for a Meet the Candidates Night before the election. He will let Jane know so she can post it on the web site for September or October.

Yvonne said the social committee would be interested in having an activity for families, such as a carnival. This was tabled for future consideration.

No new business.

Old business: we welcomed our president back after a long surgery recovery period.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:50 P.M.
