Meeting was called to order by President Steve Moran at 7P.M.

Last month's minutes were recorded by Darrell and put on the website.

Planning and Zoning Committee: John Wallick reported that the paintball proposal was withdrawn by the applicants at the last moment. He thought it might be because the noise study done and approved by the Jefferson County Health Department was for a commercial property, not residential.

Tim Karl has been replaced at Jeffco P&Z by John Wolfer. There is a new case manager for Conifer Corners also.

John will also call the county because the old yellow community notice signs for Conifer Corners hearings have still not been taken down. There is concern that when the new ones are put up, they will not be noticed because people might think they are the old ones.

Finance: Darrell reported we had \$435 in expenses last year. This year we have incurred expenses for \$300 so far. We collected \$185 in dues this year. Therefore he proposed an increase in dues for 2008. After much discussion, this was tabled. Susan Morris said we need more neighbors to join. It was also mentioned that we are planning several fund raisers this year-the Easter Egg Hunt, a BBQ, holiday party, and a Halloween party. Maybe we can partner these with other community businesses and organizations.

We also discussed letting local businesses advertise on our website. We will charge \$25/yr. "Friends and Sponsors of the PPNA" will be a separate page on our website. We presently have the Colorado Credit Union as a sponsor/partner and Mike Wilkerson of Foothills Vegetation will also be joining this alliance.

Our speaker for the evening was Alicia from the Jeffco Noxious Weed Control Division-Weed and Pest Manager. She gave an informative talk and left many interesting brochures.

Steve Moran will write a letter to Jeffco County Commissioners thanking them for excellent snow removal and road maintenance in our area last winter.
